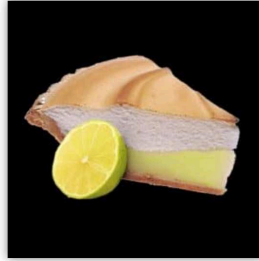

Cup (of tea, of coffee, etc.)



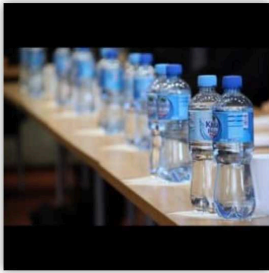

Boxes (of chocolate, etc.)



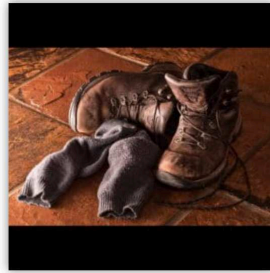

Bottle (of beer, of water, of wine, of Coke, etc.)



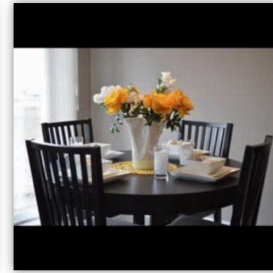
